How to Reach?

Arrive by Air: Dibrugarh (DIB) - is the nearest airport from where, a road journey of up to 10-12 hours takes you to Mechukha. Dorjeeling village is about 20 minutes from Mechukha town.

Best time to visit: October-April

Accommodation: There are 50+ homestays in Mechukha that provide more than a glimpse into local lifestyle, cuisines and authentic organic farming.

Note: An <u>Inner Line Permit</u> issued by Govt. Of Arunachal Pradesh must be secured before travelling.
