
Dear Reader,

INAUGURATION OF INDIA'S TALLEST PRAYER WHEEL



Dorjee Sempa Khorchen, the tallest prayer wheel in India, was inaugurated on 3rd January 2025 in Mechukha, Arunachal Pradesh, by the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, Shri Chowna Mein, and Shri P.D. Sona, Minister of Education, Tourism, Rural Works, Parliamentary Affairs, and Libraries. Dedicated to the memory of Shri Pasang Wangchuk Sona and Smt. Rinjin Drema Sona, its consecration was performed by His Eminence Rev Dzogchen Ganor Rinpoche, Mechukha Rinpoche, and Rev Thinley Norbu. The ceremony witnessed the presence of dignitaries, spiritual leaders, and the local community. The Dorjee Sempa Khorchen, a beacon of spirituality and heritage houses 1.6 billion prayers inscribed within. This monumental structure not only serves as a center of Buddhist spirituality but also as a cultural and tourist attraction, enriching the vibrant cultural tapestry of Mechukha.



Adding further significance to the day, the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister laid the foundation stones for several transformative developmental projects, including:
